

Annual Conference 2022 Kits and Cans Roanoke District

What traditionally had been called *Kits and Cans for Conference* has a new spin for the Roanoke District, similar to last year:

- **ONLY UMCOR Hygiene Kits and Cleaning Kits** (aka Flood Buckets) are being collected.
- Canned food and other non-perishable food items (see list below) will be collected and shared locally with feeding ministries.
- Collection in the Roanoke District will be **Saturday, June 11 from 10 AM until noon** at Southview UMC, 3539 Peters Creek Road, Roanoke.

You are asked to have a written inventory available to give volunteers when kits and cans are dropped off at the collection site (i.e. how many of each kit and how many food items).

If you are unable to make the trip to Roanoke or wish to save resources, please contact a church nearby yours and make arrangements to combine donations for delivery.
